- Age Groups:** Age as at 06/12/25 - 9/10yrs, 11yrs, 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs, 15yrs, 16yrs & over.
- Awards:** All events are heat declared winners. Medals for first 3 in each age group.
- Entry Procedure:** Clubs and individuals are encouraged to use **Sportsystems Entry Manager** which can be downloaded from the website. Individual entries may be sent by email, entry forms are not required.
- Payment:** **BACS** details are provided when the entries have been accepted.

Closing date on or before 12:00 noon Friday 21st November 2025**

Entries are accepted on a first come first served basis until the closing date or when the gala capacity has been reached, whichever occurs first. Acceptance of entry will be via the published swimmer list on the website and by email. If it is found necessary to restrict entries then swimmers will be notified by email and entry fees will be refunded as soon as possible after the closing date.

Visiting clubs are kindly requested, as far as possible, to provide 3 officials for each session, including at least one J2. It goes without saying that without your support events like this cannot happen. Lunch and refreshments provided.

Promoters Conditions

1. The Promoter is Bassetlaw Swim Squad (BSS), responsible person Liam Marshall, email liam.marshall@bpl.org.uk
2. The meet will be held under Swim England Regulations & Technical Rules and licensed Level 3 for inclusion in British Swimming Rankings.
3. Age as at 06/12/25, swimmers must be a minimum of 9yrs old on 06/12/25
4. The Female category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the 'Female' category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female.
5. Entries to the gala are taken on a strictly first come first served basis until the closing date or capacity has been reached whichever occurs first. The capacity will depend on the estimated length of each session.
6. Entry times must not exceed the published Upper Limits (not faster than). As far as possible times should be taken from British Swimming Ranking based on 25m pool. The Sportsystems entry software automatically takes the fastest times from Ranking since 01/01/2024 which may be a converted time. Where no time exists a time must be estimated and entered manually. An entry without a time will not be accepted. Once submitted entry times cannot be updated.
7. Entries and results will be managed on computer and available via the internet. By submitting entries, consent is thereby given, as required by the Data Protection Act, to the holding of personal information on a computer. Personal data, including submitted and recorded times will be available during the meet. The published information may include, but not limited to, Name, Age / Year of Birth and Club.
8. All communication will be via email and Information on the website.
9. Accepted entries will be listed on the website. It is the responsibility of the person submitting entries to check all details using the on-line system and to report any errors or omissions immediately. Errors will not be corrected on the day of meet unless this is proven to be on the part of the meet administration team.
10. Refunds will only be made up until the closing date. Subsequent withdrawals will only be refunded for bona-fide medical reasons and evidence is required. Requests for refunds will be considered after the event has been held and any monies refunded will be via bank transfer to the person or club who made the entry payment.
11. All events are heat declared winner; heats will be seeded on submitted times. All heats shall be spearheaded.
12. It is the responsibility of the swimmer and/or parent to declare to the referee any disability or medical condition that could present a health or safety risk. If such a disability or medical condition exists swimmers must produce a medical certificate confirming that their participation presents no health or safety problems.
13. A secondary strobe will not be available at this competition.
14. Events will be swum as the published schedule, over the top starts may be used at the discretion of the lead Referee.
15. It is the responsibility of the swimmers to report to the competitor's stewards in good time for their race. Heats will not wait for missing swimmers.
16. Medals will be awarded to the top 3 swimmers in each age group.

17. Clubs must ensure coaches and team managers have carried out the free Swim England DBS, Safeguarding, and qualification check and are able to show a copy when collecting a poolside pass at the venue. This check can be found by logging in to member options at www.swimmingresults.org
18. It is the responsibility of coaches, team managers and parents to ensure an acceptable standard of behavior is maintained in the pool and elsewhere in the building.
19. Swimmers leaving the poolside must be dressed appropriately with suitable footwear. Items of clothing or other articles must not be left unattended as neither the promoters nor the venue management can accept any responsibility for lost, damaged or stolen items.
20. Photographic equipment, mobile phones and image recording devices must not be used by swimmers on the poolside or in the changing rooms.
21. In the event of cancellation, the promoter shall only be responsible for the refund of entry fees, no other costs shall be considered.
22. Submitting an entry electronically via email and Sportsystems Entry Manager is deemed as acceptance of these conditions.
23. The promoter reserves the right to exclude any person not complying with these conditions and anything not covered by the above shall be decided by the promoter.
24. Expenses for Officials and Event Staff will be reviewed in line with BSS Expenses Policy that is available upon request from the Meet Promoter.
25. **Mixed Freestyle Relay SKINS** Relay team entry times must be a summation of the individuals PB's on rankings. Relay members must have entered the meet. A relay declaration form will be issued nearer to the event. Each team is made up of two Open/Male and two female competitors. They may race in any order and can change the order each round, but no substitutions are permitted. 6 teams race a 4x 50m Freestyle race. Depending on time available on the day, one or two teams will be eliminated each round. Rounds to start every 4 minutes.
