Hucknall Leisure Centre have a policy of no more than 12 swimmers in a lane during warm up so things will be particularly tight, and it is important to keep the schedule above.

Please note the start of the afternoon warm up may change and will be confirmed by the announcer following completion of the morning session.

No land-based group warm up is allowed on poolside due to lack of space. So, any group warm up outside of the pool will need to take place in the main hall.





### **Clothing/Changing Rooms**

Wetside changing rooms will be open to swimmers only during the event. Parents and Coaches should not be accessing the changing areas, if you require access, please speak to a member of Hucknall Swimming Club and we will provide a DBS escort. Lockers are available for £1 each (returned).

Swimmers are reminded of the need for sensible behaviour in the changing rooms, and that mobile phones and other image capturing devices must not be used in the changing rooms in any circumstances.

Swimmers need to bring suitable clothing and footwear to wear when walking from the main hall to the poolside. Swimmers will be escorted from the hall to poolside past the main entrance. Please ensure that swimmers have suitable warm clothing including footwear. There will be tubs provided at the start for swimmers to place their belongings into.

The leisure centre will be open to the general public during the day, the dryside changing rooms in the main hall will be open to both us and the general public.

#### Sports hall

The sports hall will be used throughout the event; there will be limited seating. But please bring along camping chairs for use in the hall. The swimmers would benefit from warm clothing within the sports hall.

Please keep swimmers under supervision whilst in the hall during the event and keep the seating area as tidy as possible.

Please ensure that areas are kept tidy, rubbish bags will be available in Coaches packs. There are no catering facilities within the leisure centre. The venue does have limited number of vending machines for hot drinks and snacks.

Therefore, please bring the food and drink required for all sessions attending.

#### **Movement of swimmers**

Swimmers will be gathered in the hall ready for races, collected and escorted poolside by stewards. All stewards will have lanyards to identify. Stewards will call swimmers for races in the hall, and due to time constraints, we cannot wait for swimmers. Team managers are asked to listen for announcements and send swimmers promptly. After racing swimmers must return to the hall via the changing rooms.



Swimmers are prohibited from the spectators' area (Balcony and seating) unless they are dry and dressed with appropriate footwear.

#### Coach's Passes

Team Managers/Coaches are required to have ordered a pass prior to the event. Form can be found here: https://www.swimmingmeetresults.co.uk/HucknallSC/

Please collect poolside passes from the PA table in the hall. All other personnel will be required to access the venue as a spectator and pay at the entrance control desk. There will be no poolside passes available to purchase on the day.

## **Awards**

Awards will be made to top 6 heat declared winners in all events and can be collected from the medal table in the sports hall.

There will be Top Boy, Top Girl & Top Visiting Club awards at the end of the day. These awards will be presented in the sports hall.

## **Parents Information:**

### Car parking

Parking is limited at the Leisure Centre. Please ensure that you park within the official parking spaces. Sunday parking at the leisure centre requires no free ticket. Please see the parking information board for parking details for the day.

The Leisure centre is a short walk from the Hucknall Tram Stop for those wishing to use public transport. Please be aware this parking is for Tram users. Alternative (paid) parking is available at Piggins Croft; Market Place a short walk from the leisure centre. Tesco carpark also has parking restrictions in place.

### **Spectators Fees:**

There is an entrance fee for spectators, which can be paid using cash or card.

Adults: £6

Concessions: £3

Tea, coffee & soft drinks are available from the Leisure Centre Refreshments Stands.



In the hall there will be a raffle, Chocolate Tombola etc. As well as the photographs for sale and Sporty Swim. Cash or card payments available inside the hall.

### **Photography:**

Note that in the interests of child protection, and in accordance with Leisure Centre policy, no photography or video will be allowed poolside or in changing areas. We have a Photographer available for professional photographs during the event, and these will be available for purchase during the day.

There will also be a dedicated photograph area in the hall to capture medal moments.
