Admission

Entry to the spectator gallery will open at 8:45am please note entry will not be possible before this time.

We can accept either cash or card payment for admission and entry prices are:

15th & 16th November 2025

All Sessions - £6.00 per session

All Day - £10.00

All weekend - £18.00

Cafe

The café at Harvey Hadden will be open all day serving drinks, plus a variety of hot and cold food.

Poolside

Please note that **ALL swimmers must enter the poolside through the changing village.**

There will be plenty of space around the pool for all clubs, please do not bring chairs. Lockers are available to store swim bags if needed for £1.

Swimmers should wear footwear, be dry and appropriately dressed when they visit the stands.

Practice starts will be in the North Pool only towards the end of each warm-up session.

Cool down pool

The South Pool will be open throughout the meet for constant warm up/swim down. This is to be managed by coaches and team managers.

However, if we have reports of the pool not be used as intended there is the risk that it can be closed for all, so we appreciate that swimmers are monitored at all times.

Photography

The use of mobile phones and the taking of photographs are not permitted on the poolside or changing village. Anyone found using a mobile phone in the changing village or adjacent areas will be immediately excluded from the competition and escorted off the premises.

Parents are permitted to take pictures and videos from the spectator area.



Car Parking

Parking in both the main and overflow car parks at Harvey Hadden are free of charge all day. Please park considerately.

Duty of Care

The main aim of our meet is fast swimming and enjoyment. To aid us in providing a smooth-running, trouble-free event, could we ask you to pass on the following messages to the swimmers and parents attending.

The use of mobile phones and the taking of photographs in changing village is strictly prohibited. Anyone found using a mobile phone in the changing village or adjacent areas will be immediately excluded from the competition and escorted off the premises.

Access to the changing village is only available to swimmers competing in the meet or those carrying meet accreditation. Parents **are not** allowed into the changing village *under any circumstances*.

Verbal abuse directed at the promoter, officials, and any volunteer acting under the direction of the promoter will not be tolerated. The promoter reserves the right to ask any person or persons behaving in this manner to leave any areas managed by the promoter for the remainder of the competition.
