

Dear Swimmer / Guardian,

We are pleased to return to the same format as last year for 2024 club championships based on the scoring system rather than the more events you enter the more points you can gain. There is no scoring system for our 7-8 year old swimmers to encourage swimmers to try all four 25m events.

The aims of the system for swimmers aged 9 years and over are to:

- Introduce a fairer scoring system to determine the championship, which recognises the level of performance in an event rather than just the finish order.
- Incentivise swimmers to swim a broad range of events/distances but allowing them to choose their races.

## HOW WILL WE ACHIEVE THIS?

The scoring system will use FINA points to score each swim:

What are FINA Points?

FINA points allow comparison of results among different events. Using a FINA point table, point values are assigned to a swimming performance based on the time swum. More points for world class performances, typically 1000 or more and fewer for slower performances.

The base times are defined every year, linked to the World Record that was approved by FINA.

This means the points allocated for each swim will reflect the level of performance rather than just the finish order.

The scoring system will also group swims into 5 categories, which are shown on the entry form and only the top 2 FINA point scores in each category will count towards the overall championship. The annual Club Championships is for all our club members. For some it will be their first competition, for others it provides an opportunity to try new events, others push themselves to achieve County Qualifying Times.

No system is perfect, but we have given a lot of thought to the changes we had made to ensure our Club Championship provides challenge and opportunity for all our swimmers.

The Female category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the 'Female' category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female

The order of Events and allocation of Events to specific Sessions may be changed at the discretion of the organisers. The Referee's decision is final.

Any swimmer not behaving in an appropriate manner on poolside will be asked to leave and may not be allowed to swim. Please see the swimmers code of conduct on our website.

All swimmers must stay poolside until they have been told they can leave by coaching staff. Swimmers leaving poolside at any time must inform the Senior Coach first. Any swimmer not poolside prior to their race may miss their swim, as coaches and Team mangers will not come looking for them

The organisers do not accept liability for lost property.

All Entries and Swimmers Data will be held on computer; Entry to the Meet implies consent as required by the Data Protection Act 1998. Results and Swimmers Data will be submitted to the Swim England & displayed on our Club Website. Any point not dealt with by these notes will be at the discretion of the promoter.

#### AWARDS

All Events are Heat Declared Winners. Heats will be arranged and spearheaded according to the entry times. Points will be awarded using Fina Points. There will be 5 categories and your top 2 swims from each category will count towards the overall Championship placing. (Open/Male and Female separate) Age groups 8 & under, 9, 10,11, 12, 13 & 14, 15 & 16 and Open

### <u>Age as of 31<sup>st</sup> December 2024</u>

All Swimmers must be SE registered and a member of Retford Swimming Club before 19<sup>th</sup> October 2024 with all subscription fees up to date.

Entries must be received no later than 8pm on the 1<sup>st</sup> November 2024. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. Over the top/side by side starts may be used at the promoter's discretion. Any changes will be published on our club's website.

Swimmers must not be a member of any other swimming club outside of Nottinghamshire Swim Association. Swimmers must not have taken part in another clubs Club Championships within the same year

No entries will be accepted after the closing date or during the meet unless due to the promoter's error or omission.
